## Twenty-second Annual Scripture Memory Awards

When is it?

During the Anders or Houghton Family Christmas celebration or another time as arranged.

Who can participate?

YOU — if you are 18 years old or less by December 31 of this year.

How does it work?

For each **whole** Bible verse you can say comfortably from memory with reference (book, chapter, and verse), you earn one dollar. A few ground rules to keep in mind:

1. All verses must be **perfect, complete** and **flow smoothly** from memory. No cue cards.
2. **You MUST bring your verses in written form.** Any standard version of the Bible may be used.
3. All verses must be said in **one sitting** to David or Kenya or other designated listener.
4. Each text may be recited **once** - duplicate references are for your edification - not remuneration.

Will there be bonuses?

Of course! Bonuses are given for learning these selected portions of Scripture:

Genesis 1:1-31 (The Creation Story)	\$5.00
Exodus 20:1-17 (The Ten Commandments)	\$5.00
Psalms 23	\$1.00
Psalms 100	\$1.00
Psalms 119	\$25.00
Luke 2:1-20 (The Christmas Story)	\$5.00
1 Corinthians 13	\$5.00

Legacy Verses—new in 2004!

For each relative and their chosen verse (or passage) there will be a \$1.00 bonus. One bonus dollar per relative AND the verses must be CLEARLY marked on the written list of your verses in order to count.

Show this part to your **parents.** It is **very** important!

**Please** listen to your children's verses before-hand to help them select the verses they know **well.**

We will move past verses that aren't yet polished out of respect for the time and efforts of others.

Is there a limit to how much I can earn?

Yes. Each child may earn a maximum of \$5000 each year. Extra verses are just for fun!
